How to Link to external CSS style sheet

In the <head> section of each page

```
<!--link to external stylesheet CSS (styles.css)-->
<link rel="stylesheet" href="styles.css">
```

How to include an internal style sheet

In the <head> section

```
<!--Internal stylesheets CSS can be added to head section-->
<style>
  CSS goes here
</style> <!--End of CSS-->
```
